

COVID-19 Lockdown Circulars Index

On July 1, 2020, India entered the Unlock 2 phase, which will continue up till July 31, 2020.

The following are relevant orders that highlight the current status of lockdown measures and permitted activities in various states.

A. Central Circular

All activities are permitted outside of containment zones, except – operation of school, colleges, educational and training institutes; international air travel of passengers; metro rail; various public recreational places, functions, and large congregations.ii. Movement of individuals is strictly prohibited between 10 PM to 5 AM, throughout the country, except for essential activities.iii. Lockdown is to be limited to containment zones, wherein movement for only essential activities and medical emergencies shall be permitted.iv. No restriction on inter-state and intra-state movement of persons and goods, and no separate permits are required for the same.v. Employers are to ensure installation of Aarogya Setu app by all employees, on best effort basis.

All activities are permitted outside of containment zones, except those expressly prohibited.iii. Movement of individuals is strictly prohibited between 10 PM to 5 AM, except for essential activities.iv. Lockdown is to be limited to containment zones, wherein movement for only essential activities and medical emergencies shall be permitted.v. Intra state buses are operating with a maximum of 20 passengers and other modes of transportation have been allowed.vi. All private and government offices, industrial establishments have been allowed to function with full strength. However, work from home is encouraged.vii. Employers are to ensure safety at all workplaces and installation of Aarogya Setu app by all employees, on best effort basis.

All activities are permitted outside of containment zones, except those expressly prohibited.ii. Movement of individuals is strictly prohibited between 10 PM to 5 AM, except for essential activities.iii. No restrictions on inter-state and intra-state movement of persons and goods.

					iv. Employers are to ensure safety at all workplaces and installation of Aarogya Setu app by all employees, on best effort basis.

All activities are permitted outside of containment zones, except those expressly prohibited. ii. For Municipal corporations of Mumbai Metropolitan Region, including MCGM, municipal corporations of Pune, Solapur, Aurangabad, Jalgaon, Malegaon, Nashik, Dhule, Amravati, Nagpur, and Akola – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. All government offices permitted to operate with 15% strength or 15 people, whichever is higher. b. All private offices permitted to operate with 10% strength or 10 people, whichever is higher. c. All industrial establishments presently open are allowed to continue to operate. d. Private and public transport is allowed to operate, subject to limitations on number of passengers. iii. For the rest of state – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. All public and private transport permitted subject to limitations on number of passengers. b. Intra-district bus service permitted to operate with 50% strength. c. All activities are permitted, unless expressly prohibited.

All activities are permitted outside of containment zones, except those expressly prohibited. ii. Movement of individuals is strictly prohibited between 8 PM to 5 AM, except for essential activities. iii. Lockdown is to be limited to containment zones, wherein movement for only essential activities and medical emergencies shall be permitted. iv. Sunday lockdown will be implemented for all Sundays, beginning from 5 July 2020 to 2 August 2020. v. All government and related offices, except those relating to essential services, shall remain closed for every Sunday till 2nd week of August 2020. vi. Employers are to ensure safety at all workplaces and installation of Aarogya Setu app by all employees, on best effort basis. <p>Additionally, an advisory has been issued to workplaces pertaining to safety norms to be adhered to by the workplaces. Complete lockdown to be observed on all Sundays falling in the month of July. ii. Operation of both private and government buses suspended for the period from 1 July to 15 July 2020. iii. E-pass system will be in place for inter-district and inter-state travel.

Multiple activities have been allowed to operate from 6 July 2020 in areas falling under jurisdiction of Greater Chennai Police, Tiruvallur, Chengalpet and Kancheepuram, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. IT/ITEs offices permitted to operate with company provided transport with upto 50% strength, subject to a maximum of 80 persons. b. All private offices, establishments and export-oriented units can function with 50% strength. c. Taxis, cabs, and autos are permitted, subject to limitations on number of passengers. <p>v. For rest of the state, multiple activities have been permitted from 1 July 2020, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. IT/ITES offices permitted to operate with 100% strength with at least 20% work from home. b. All private offices, industrial establishments and export-oriented units permitted to operate with 100% strength. c. Taxis, cabs, and autos are permitted, subject to limitations on number of passengers. <p>vi. Employers are to ensure safety at all workplaces and installation of Aarogya Setu app by all employees, on best effort basis.</p>
